Safety Inspection Report July/October 2022

Summary

Introduction

A Safety Inspection of all graves and memorials located at Haxey Road Cemetery, Misterton and The Old Burial Ground, located at Church Street Misterton was carried out between 14th July and 17th October 2022. A full detailed report is available in electronic format from the Parish Council Clerk.

Brief detail of the inspection

Each memorial is individually inspected to check for stability and excessive movement. If a headstone is found to be unstable but not imminently dangerous, the Council will notify the grave owner to rectify the situation. If a headstone is found to be unstable and imminently dangerous, then the headstone will be laid flat immediately for the safety of the general public and Council operatives. The grave owner will be notified and can then decide to leave it laying flat or repair it at their cost.

Weather and Ground Conditions

The summer of 2022 has been exceptionally dry and ground conditions at the time of the inspections in July were very dry and hard whilst in October it was slightly wetter but still relatively firm. Ambient air temperatures were above average for the time of year.
